DY opened with sharing information from letter from Ballymore re: Residents Association sent to all Ballymore developments. It was agreed that we would respond to the email as fully as possible. DY reported that the wider group of RA chairs had not been active recently.

Report on meeting with Ballymore's Managing Director

25 April -

Service charges (SC) – no info for 2021; no invoices for previous years or statements.

No SC statements sent out , or credits taken into account on service charge invoices

Outstanding debt on service charge – £430k. There are improvements with the introduction of Propman but there are still delays in delivering on commitments

Service charge surgery attended by 35 people.

Managements accounts 1Q 2022 by end May to be posted to leaseholders. Can this also include cost control (under CPI?) Cost of energy increase – how is this being managed? Freeholder subsidising cost

No price cap for Community energy suppliers; govt under pressure to apply caps.

Property issues

Lifts - Bridgewater and Kent refurbished and look good. Going forward, less expensive to maintain.

Globe, Java letter boxes repaired; numbers for Bridgewater letterboxes awaited – Echo lobby to be refreshed

Cooker hoods – CHAG group to take this forward, RA not involved following agreement at last meeting.

Cracked windows - no clarity yet from Ballymore.

Hot water – no clarity or communication on issues. Issues are not always communal but still concerns over frequency of outages.

Ballymore too quick to blame resident, rather than investigate more, and have a plan to resolve.

Justin has agreed to produce a 'trouble shooting' FAQ for hot water issues

Tower Hamlets investigated complaints from residents, and were satisfied with Ballymore response.

Security and Safety

Recent burglary – possible targeted. Security responded; damaged door repaired quickly. Suggestion of setting up Neighbourhood Watch. Mel to investigate

Doors not closing properly - rectified

Fire action notice - Installed

Modena – entry phone issue ongoing. Echo entry phone resolved.

Lighting improvement in City Island Way to be addressed

Bollards at GLH to prevent illegal parking

BAML discussing poor ticketing with PCN
16 May – GLH car park opening scheduled but delayed

Gym - cleaning; studio floor dirty. Worms in steam room.

Plants in Kent very dry; new plants in garden installed.

GLH and LCI - dead trees to be replaced. New benches in Hopewell Square - agreed they are nice

Communal laundry - to be followed up by BAML

Communal bbg - little garden by Kent facing river under

consideration

Cinema – not working; works ongoing to improve reliability. Noted at the committee meeting that it has been shut for many weeks now.

Soda and friends open – very nice

Ballymore comms - trying to improve and to be proactive.

Sports facility – no confirmed date for opening Cardboard compactor – may provide some income, and improve waste disposal

AirBNB - Ballymore aware; tracking and if 3 occasions, legal action taken
